Inspire

Sioux Center Health is now offering Inspire Sleep Therapy, a groundbreaking treatment for obstructive sleep apnea (OSA) in patients who are unable to use Continuous Positive Airway Pressure (CPAP) therapy. OSA, which affects 22 million Americans, occurs when the airway collapses during sleep, blocking the flow of oxygen to the brain, leading to disruptive sleep, mood and memory problems, and increased risks of accidents, stroke, heart attack, and even death. Inspire works by using mild stimulation to open the airway during sleep, allowing oxygen to flow naturally, and is activated by a small handheld remote before bed and deactivated upon waking. The safety and effectiveness of Inspire were demonstrated in the five-year STAR clinical trial, which showed significant reductions in sleep apnea events and improvements in quality of life, with over 150 peer-reviewed publications supporting the results. 




